Who

Along with participating students, teachers are welcome to attend any and all instructional sessions through out the week. Parents and teachers are also welcome to attend the Welcome Session on the first day and the Research Fair and Closing Session on the last day of the camp.

When

Camp starts at 9:30 on Monday, July 10. OCTET runs Monday through Saturday until 3 pm. **Keep in mind that the new research component will take place after camp ends each day. Instructional sessions will take place on the UCF campus in the Biological Sciences Building (BIO) room 206.
